Wear Friends.

On this fifth Sunday of Lent we are celebrating the third scrutiny with Yeni Hughes who is preparing to receive the three sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) at the Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord Mass at 7.00 pm on Saturday 16 April at St John's Glenorchy. For this reason, we are using the Year A Readings at the Masses in the parish this weekend.

In the Gospel, Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead as a sign of His Lordship. Martha, the sister of Lazarus makes a profession of faith in Jesus, even though she doubts.

This miracle of the raising of Lazarus from the dead is meant to strengthen our faith in Jesus. If He can bring someone back from the dead to this earthly life, then we can put our trust in Him when He says that He is the Resurrection and the Life. He can raise us from the dead and give us eternal life to share the glory of God forever in peace and

happiness with all people who have put their faith in Him.

In the meantime, He does not abandon us. He surrounds us with the love and support of the Christian community.

Jesus understands the sorrow, the emptiness and the confusion often caused by death. He went through it Himself - He died on the Cross. He continues to be our faithful Friend who journeys beside us to help us carry our own cross. Jesus showed us that we too can one day overcome death, not by avoiding it but by going through it ourselves. Jesus has opened for us eternal life by His own death and resurrection.
