

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel, Jesus gives His final instructions to His close followers on a mountain top. Then He ascends to heaven with His human and divine natures.

It was also on a mountain top where Jesus first taught them His Beatitudes based on non-violence and mercy: "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are the merciful...etc..." Now, before He leaves them, He reminds them to "observe all commandments He gave them" while He was with them.

With His ascension into heaven Jesus becomes the Lord of time and history. But His Lordship does not enslave anyone. Online training program for Ministers of the Word As you know, being a reader is not about reading, but proclaiming Sacred Scriptures or the Prayer of the Faithful in a way that penetrates hearts: the Minister of the Word is a vessel for God's Word. Proclaiming the Scripture and the Prayer of the Faithful well increases people's capacity to respond to what they hear, which can transform and change their lives.

Our four-week online training program will teach new and experienced Ministers of the Word practical skills, such as timing, spacing, the use of emphasis and silence, and arguably the most useful skill – correctly pronouncing Biblical words, names, and places. Completed over four weekly online modules, with live (Zoom) classroom sessions (held on a weekday evening), the training program also offers a step by step guide on how to write the Prayer of the Faithful, and how to proclaim the Word in the Sequences, additional readings at the Easter and Pentecost vigils, and lay led celebrations of the Word.

Our next program will start on 24 May and we would welcome to it any of your parishioners who are interested in participating.
