**Family Ministry Coordinator Report:** There have been a number of new initiatives this year to help engage young families alongside all members of our parish community. Following the success of the Community Picnic 2021, we followed up with a number of opportunities during Holy Week & Easter, which also coincided with the resumption of the Sacramental Program.

The Interactive Stations of the Cross were met with an overwhelmingly positive response from all ages: Individuals, friends, families, lenten groups, couples, school groups, and school staff groups (amongst other combinations of people) all walked this journey with Jesus engaging their hearts, hands, and minds in prayer. We also saw our young people involved in the Holy Thursday Mass, helping to prepare us for the Liturgy of the Eucharist, as well as in the prayerful presentation of the Good Friday Stations of the Cross.

Earlier this year we established a Schools of the Parish Ministry Team to increase School-Parish relationship. This team meets twice a term and includes the RECs of all three Primary Schools, the Director of Ministry at Mackillop College, our Parish Priest, and Family Ministry Coordinator. In addition to gaining support and assistance for the initiatives mentioned above (and with thanks to the John Paul II students who cut out the crosses for the Interactive Stations), team members have already begun working together on joint staff spiritual development opportunities that, among other benefits, promotes a greater understanding of parish. Stay tuned for more to come from this team.

We look forward to welcoming our Sacramental candidates on the weekends of 1-2 and 15-16 May for the first of their Rites at Mass as they prepare for Confirmation, which will be celebrated in the first week of June.
