Dear Parish Family,

Today is the Feast Day of Australia's First Saint, Mary of the Cross MacKillop. In collaboration with Julian Tenison-Woods, Mary MacKillop founded the Sisters of St Joseph in Australia and her legacy lives on in the work of the Sisters and in the many and varied ministries that bear her name. Our own MacKillop College is one such community, and it was fantastic to share in their Feast Day celebrations on Friday.

Speaking of MacKillop College, I am yet to acknowledge the appointment of Mr Stephen Hill as the ongoing Principal of this Catholic Secondary College in our Parish. Stephen came to us from St Patrick's College, Ballarat and has hit the ground running. This weekend, we also welcome to our Masses the children who are preparing to receive the Eucharist for the first time. We assure them of our prayerful support as they undertake this most exceptional journey.
