It wasn't until I sat on the plane for nearly 5 hours that I realised how big this country is. Experience is indeed the best teacher. On our arrival, we were warmly welcomed by the warm weather. Although the weather wasn't very pleasant to a couple of our pilgrims, I simply loved it and I'm sure that you know the reason. I simply want to share some of the highlights and my experiences with you in a few sentences

- The first truth that I must tell you is that there is hope for our Australian Church. God is still working actively among our young people.
- The zeal and energy of everyone expressed during praise and worship sessions really touched me all through the festival. Since most of you were not there, imagine what it'd be like to be among 6,000 people who are singing and praising God. It gave me so much courage and hope as a young priest.
- 6,000 young people, with about 30bishops and over 70priests were present.
- The theme of the festival was "Listen to what the Spirit is saying."
- The festival attracted great speakers from within and outside Australia. Some topics that the speakers touched on included- music, sexuality, spirituality, love, relationship, marriage, evangelization, individual testimonies of conversion, etc.

Lastly, it is my hope that as from next year, we will have our parish youth group. This will be possible with your support and prayers.
