## Dear Parish Family,

As we reach the fourth Sunday of Advent, our focus quickly shifts to Christmas itself, and the readings today tell the story of the birth of Jesus. Isaiah foretells the virgin birth and the awesome promise of the Saviour's name: "God is with us". St Matthew recalls this name and reassures Joseph that the Lord is at work here. St Paul reasserts the incarnation of the Son of God as a descendant of David. In other words, the entire Bible points to this moment, the birth of Jesus, as the final intervention of God in human history. After the first Christmas, the world is never the same again.

With our tired modern eyes, we often fail to grasp the significance of this. We are grappling with the relevance of the Christmas story in the midst of a commercial frenzy which seemingly contradicts everything Jesus talked about and in the face of a society rejecting the concept of God.

I think we need to move beyond the celebration of the birth of Jesus to rediscover the significance of the birth of Christ. This takes honesty and courage, because we first must admit that we need Christ, our savior. From what do we need to be saved? With security, education and opportunity, we have developed an independent mindset that tells us we can achieve anything we desire, and our lives have never been so good. Yet still there lurks a frustration, a disappointment, a drive to escape the deeper questions through drugs, alcohol and even suicide.

Words like peace, joy and love have become irrelevant, even trite. And yet they are the very real gift of the Christ child. A deep abiding peace which satisfies the human heart, a joy which gives strength in the midst of darkness and pain and a love which transcends the human experience and brings happiness and fulfilment through service of others, especially the poor. Our world needs these gifts and this mindset more than ever, so the Christmas story has never been so relevant.

May the celebration of the birth of Christ bring you and your family peace, joy and love this Christmas.
