My sincere thanks for your concern and support during my 3 weeks in hospital and time of convalescence. Happy to say I am now back home at Dodges Ferry and improving day by day.

I am overwhelmed by the number of people praying for my recovery. Your prayers have been answered as I have survived what was a serious accident. Perhaps more turned to prayer than I ever inspired by my preaching!

I would like to pay tribute to all who cared for me, doctors, nurses and ward staff, ambulance etc. both at the Royal Hobart and St John's Hospitals. They were helpful, efficient, positive and friendly. Nothing was a problem. Not only am I so grateful for your support, but my 3 weeks in hospital affirmed many aspects of my priestly life with so many hospital personnel recalling baptisms, funerals, school activities and other occasions. This is a real boost.

You could have thought falling off a ladder was more in character for me than if I had broken a leg practicing Ballet. "Bob Builder" has been grounded and now has a ladder for sale! The only ladder I will be interested in (with diminishing enthusiasm during this messed up AFL season) will be how high the Bombers are on the ladder.

I would be grateful if you would convey my gratitude to your people for their concern and support, and feel free to use any of even all of this letter if it is helpful.
