Dear Parish Family,

During the week Pope Francis released his message for the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which is being held on Sunday 25th July, the day before the feast day of Saints Anne and Joachim, the grandparents of Jesus. This initiative forms part of the Church's current Year of the Family, which focuses on various aspects of family life. Pope Francis has chosen the theme: "I am with you always" (Mt 28:20) for this inaugural celebration. Identifying himself to be an elderly person and speaking to 'Grandparents & Elderly Friends', he says: "The whole Church is close to you – to us – and cares about you, loves you and does not want to leave you alone!" In his message he speaks about the impact of the pandemic on the elderly and the story of God sending an angel to be with Joachim when he felt estranged from society. He says:

"That is the meaning of this Day ... may every grandfather, every grandmother, every older person, especially those among us who are most alone, receive the visit of an angel! The Lord is always – always – close to us. He is close to us with new possibilities, new ideas, new consolations, but always close to us. You know the Lord is eternal; he never, ever goes into retirement."

We look forward to celebrating World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in our parish and encourage you to extend a special invitation to your grandparents, or your grandchildren, or an elderly friend to attend Mass together on that weekend to celebrate with each other and our wider parish family. We hear of the closeness of God in this Sunday's readings, too. Just as Jesus commands the girl, through faith, to get up and keep living even when all seems lost, we are encouraged to trust in the closeness of God and keep moving forward as he calls us in all the seasons of our lives.
