Dear Parish family,

Good morning and happy new month.

A Child with her foster mum came up to me immediately after Mass a few days ago, with tears rolling down her eyes, she said – 'I am worried whether or not my mum is in heaven.' At first, I didn't quite know how to respond, but as I knelt in front of this child and her foster mum, my little faith became ever more certain. God created us out of love, he sustains us in love and at death, he leads us home in perfect love. Your mum, I said is part of this love story.

I pray that we all come to know divine consolation through the death and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.
