Dear Parish Family,

In consultation with the Parish Pastoral Council, we have discerned the need for a new formal pastoral role in our parish in the broadly termed area of "family ministry". Funding has been allocated in the Parish Budget for a casual two day per week position with a job description including the establishment of programs and events that particularly engage families with younger children in the life of our parish community. In time, this could include children's liturgy, structured follow up to the preparation program for the sacraments of initiation, faith formation opportunities for younger parents, baptism preparation and follow up, youth ministry initiatives: the scope is enormous and the goals and expectations must remain realistic, but it is an exciting moment nonetheless. Details are on the parish website, Facebook page and church noticeboards. Please add this initiative to your prayers in the coming weeks and circulate it to anyone you think may be interested in applying.

Another group of young people commenced their preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation this week. They will celebrate their First Reconciliation in early November after a Covid-accelerated program of preparation. Please keep these children and their families in your prayers as their prayer cards are added to the 2020 cohort already in the churches.

On a sad note, Fr Liam Floyd died peacefully on Wednesday evening this week. Fr Liam was the last surviving Irish priest to serve the parishes of Tasmania through his more than 60 years of priestly ministry. May he rest in peace.
